- **Neighbourhood Food Program** is available each Thursday at 11:00 a.m. If you are unable to come at this time, you may call the centre by 9:00 a.m. on Thursday and ask that food to be put aside for you. Food must be picked up by 5:00 p.m. unless other arrangements have been made with staff.
- Lakeshore South Community Association (LSCA, formerly Sunnydale Community Association), your neighbourhood association, works in partnership with House of Friendship to provide important resources and services for this community through the Sunnydale Community Centre. If you would like to apply for gifts, please bring your calendar or day planner since you will be asked to choose an appointment time to pick up your gifts when you apply.

Community Centre Programs:

After School Program (ASP) for Grades 3-6 is offered on Wednesdays from 3:45-5:00 p.m. Pre-registration is required.

Bridge to Music, a partnership with K-W Symphony, provides music lessons for students between 6 and 13 years.

Career/Work Coaching, a service available through Conestoga Career Centre, provides assistance for people looking for work or training. Please call Dana at 519-885-0300 extension 5236, for an appointment.

Coffee & Conversation offers a safe and caring environment for women to make friends, share knowledge and experiences, network and learn about their community. Child care is provided for children 2 to 5 years.

Cooking in Community is led by a Community Nutrition Worker and provides opportunities to learn more about shopping, healthy eating and food preparation. A Preschool Program is available for children 2 to 5 years of age.

English Conversation Circle offers adults an opportunity to improve their abilities to speak English. Child care may be available for children 2 to 5 yrs. Family Outreach Program assists families with children under 18 years of age that are experiencing low income to access the services they need in their community. Fariba Chaghand, our Family Outreach Worker, is generally available at Sunnydale Community Centre from Monday to Thursday. Her hours are noted on the calendar as "Outreach", but are subject to change. Whenever possible, please call Fariba at 519-498-6985 to book an appointment.

Healthy Changes is a diabetes support group for residents and others interested in making changes in support of a healthier lifestyle; it meets the fourth Wednesday of every month at 6:30 and all are welcome. For more information, please contact Laurie Strome at lestrome@gmail.com.

Sewing Group meets weekly to help with mending and basic sewing projects. Sewing machines are provided. Child care is not available.

Time for Us is facilitated by a Peer Health Worker and offers opportunities to discuss a variety of topics relating to physical, emotional, psychological and spiritual health for ourselves and our families. Child care is available for children 2 to 5 years.
